OF THE AUSCHWITZ-BIRKENAU CAMP**

Thursday, January 7th, 6:00 p.m.

Auschwitz – My Inspiration – vernissage of the exhibition of drawings by the artist Paweł Warchoł, residing and working in Oświęcim.

Wednesday, January 13th, 6:00 p.m.

The Rescued – The Rescuers; Consideration of Memory – lecture by Marian TURSKI.

Thursday, January 14th, 6:00 p.m.

The Portraitist – screening of the documentary film directed by Ireneusz DOBROWOLSKI, TVP 2005., 52 min. After the screening, meeting with Wilhelm BRASSE moderated by Leszek SZUSTER, Director of the International Youth Meeting Center in Oświęcim.

It is a story of Wilhelm BRASSE, pre-war photographer-portraitist from Katowice, who in August 1940 was sent in one of the first transports to Auschwitz, camp no. 3444. In the camp, he documented life until the liberation. After the war, due to personal trauma, he was never able to take pictures again.
